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Dear Parent or Guardian:

Welcome to Lake Forest District 67. The following information is important in meeting the health and safety needs of our students.

These **mandatory** requirements are set by the State of Illinois for students entering **early childhood/preschool programs, kindergarten, second grade, sixth grade, and all new students to the District.**

1. A physical exam must be done within one year prior to preschool, kindergarten, sixth grade, and new students entering the District. This exam must be recorded on the Certificate of Child Health Examination form.
2. The physical exam form must be signed and dated by your health care provider. The name, address and telephone number must be clearly written or stamped on the form.
3. The health history section of the form must be completed, dated, and signed by the parent.
4. Immunizations must be completed according to the schedule of the Illinois Department of Public Health.
5. Lead Risk Assessment must be completed for children 6 years of age and under.
6. Diabetic Screening must be completed for students entering kindergarten, sixth grade and all new students to the District.
7. Proof of dental examination in grades kindergarten, second and sixth by May 15th of the current school year.
8. A current physical examination (completed within one year of student participation in tryouts or practice) must be on file for all students participating in interscholastic sports. This must be recorded on the Certificate of Child Health Examination form.
9. Proof of a vision examination in kindergarten and for any new student entering an Illinois school for the first time.

No child will be permitted to attend school after October 14th unless they meet these health requirements. All forms are due in the school office by the first day of school. If you need assistance or explanation, please contact the school nurse.

Students transferring from out of state or country must present a physical exam completed within one year prior to Illinois school entrance on a comparable form, and must comply with the immunization schedule. **All transfer students** shall have **30 days** following registration to comply with the health examination and immunization requirements.

If your child requires any type of **medication** during the school day, a Medication Authorization Form must be completed by the parent and signed by the prescribing physician. No medication (**prescription or non-prescription**) can be given to your child at school without these forms on file.

Please make your appointments early so your child's health record is complete by the start of school. It is advisable to make copies of the form for your own records.

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
